e campus has blossomed into an academic, social, and cultural hub. is past academic ear, NKU o ered 68 bachelor's degrees, 6 associate degrees, 23 graduate programs, 29 graduate certi cates, a juris doctor, and doctoral degrees in educational leadership and nursing practice. We enrolled students from 104 Kentuck counties, 40 states, and 54 countries. Students come from across the common ealth and around the orld for the personali ed education that has de ned NKU since its founding.

Despite our gro th, the Universit still o ers small classes taught b outstanding teacher-scholars ho care deepl about the ellbeing and success of their students. Students continue to ork alongside revered professors on undergraduate research projects that address the challenges facing our communities and our orld.
